

FLOWER POLICY FOR NAZARETH PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

1. Please use only live plants, live cut flowers, or appropriate silk arrangements.
2. Many arrangements come in compressed paper containers. These paper containers can be placed in an urn to improve their appearance. The church has a selection of urns in the bottom right corner cabinet at the rear of the Social Hall. If a church urn is used please return it to the cabinet in the Social Hall. Please **DO NOT** take church urns home. Baskets may also be used.
3. The maximum height of the arrangement, including the container should not be over 27".
4. Flowers should be placed on the small square table to the left of the pulpit on Sunday morning 30 minutes prior to start of the Service.
5. If you have a special dedication or memorial information for your flowers, please let the church secretary know by the Wednesday prior to your flower date.
6. Suggested florists:
 - “A Arrangement” and “River Falls Florist” have keys to the church and will deliver flowers on Saturday and place them in the sanctuary for you.
 - “Coggins Florist” does not have a key to the church but they are familiar with our flower policy.
 - Arrangements using flowers from home gardens are acceptable.
7. Please be sure to remove your flowers at the end of the Service.
